(1) 開講日 : 7 月 15 日(土)、10 月 7 日(土)、**※ 11 月 10 日 (金)、12 月 9 日 (土)、2017 年 1 月 13 日(土)**

趣旨 : EU (欧州連合) 加盟国の在日大使館および駐日 EU 代表部の大使や外交官から直接話を聞くことで、欧州連合 (EU) や日・EU 関係についての理解を深める。

(3) 募集対象 : 1 年生 175 名 (各コース 35 名)

(4) 内容 : ネイティブ講師による大学レベルの一般教養講座の授業を All English で体験。教育学・ビジネス学・心理学・天文学・環境学の 5 分野に分かれ、ケーススタディを用いた講義・ディスカッションを交えて専門分野の知識を増やす。同時に英語でプレゼンテーションを行うテクニックも習得する。最終日(1 月 13 日)にはケーススタディで学んだ理論を基にグループプレゼンテーションを実施する。参加者全員に修了証書、優秀者 15 名 (各講座 3 名) にはハナニラバッジを授与。

A 講座 Education Course (教育学講座)

General Themes: In the case studies, students will look at three areas related to education and try to apply them to their classes. Through lectures, group work, and a variety of activities students will learn about the following:

① VAK (Visual, Auditory, and Kinesthetic) Learning Styles ② Multiple Intelligences ③ Cooperative Learning

Student Projects: Students will work on preparing and giving two main presentations. One will be a solo-presentation (done alone) and the other will be a group presentation.

B 講座 Business Course (ビジネス学講座)

General Themes: Students will learn about some basic business principles and then use them in a variety of activities and case studies. Through lectures, discussion sessions, group work, and analysis activities students will learn about the following: ① Monopolistic Competition ② Business Environment Analysis ③ Marketing

Student Project: Students will give a number of mini-presentation and at least one major presentation. The major presentation will be done in groups, and each group will present their individual case study.

C 講座 Psychology Course (心理学講座)

General Themes: Students will receive an introduction to the field of psychology. They will gain a better understanding of how broad the subject is. They will look at some specific and concrete examples of psychology at work. Through lectures, pair work, and interactive activities students will learn about the following:

① Psychology of Sales ② Behavioral Psychology

Student Project: Students will have mini-presentations and a major presentation based on course themes. They may have to do some research and / or observation based tasks.

D 講座 Astronomy Course (天文学講座)

General Themes: Students will learn some of the fundamentals of planetary astronomy. By taking notes on lectures, participating in pair and group activities, and giving short presentations, students will learn about the following: ① Missions to the planets and their moons ② The composition and characteristics of the planets and moons ③ Solar system debris

Student Projects: Students will have mini-presentations and a major presentation based on course themes. They will have to do some research

University of California at Davis, USA Bachelor of Arts - Major: German Literature in German. He also did 2 years of course work in physics, chemistry, and math. He has been a full-time teacher at HIUC for over 20 years. He has taught the HIUC college-level astronomy class 4 times. In addition, he has written three of the textbooks that HIUC uses as part of its distance learning program. He has made and given various astronomy based lessons / workshops at schools around the Kansai area.

E 講座 Environmentology Course (環境学講座)

General Themes: Students will become familiar with the fundamental terminology used in Environmental Science and develop the skills to analyze and develop an understanding of current environmental issues and their effect on the world. Through lectures, case-studies and group-based research activities, students will learn how to address 3 specific environmental issues and be encouraged to find creative and scientifically based solutions to them. The three issues will focus on:

① The Water Cycle ② Extinction ③ Alternative Forms of Energy

Student Project: Students will work together in teams on specific problems and present their ideas in a professional and scientific manner to the rest of the class. They will conduct Question & Answer sessions and develop the mind-set of scientists working in the field.
